

# **Susan Pollack Education Scholarship**

# **Application Details & Eligibility Requirements**

We are proud to announce the Susan Pollack Education Scholarship. Two scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$2,500. This scholarship is in memory of Susan Pollack, who passed away in 2014 and was the wife of Martin Pollack, one of the owners/founders of Butterfly Wonderland and OdySea in the Desert Entertainment Complex.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE: Nov. 30, 2019** 

AMOUNT AWARDED: Scholarships are in the amount of \$2,500. Two are awarded each year.

To be eligible for The Susan Pollack Education Scholarship:

- An applicant must be a current/entering undergraduate or graduate student at any of the three Arizona Universities Arizona State University, Northern Arizona University or University of Arizona.
- The student must have declared a major/focus or have intent to declare a major/focus in one
  of the following disciplines (entomology, botany, zoology, biology, horticulture or
  conservation).

Selection will be based upon the student's academic history and the student's contributions and demonstrated commitment to the related field.

# Scholarship candidate:

- 1: Is seeking a degree in entomology, botany, zoology, biology, horticulture or conservation.
- 2: Is active in the entomology world (i.e. hobby, organizations/clubs, volunteering, community projects).
- 3: Will be a full-time undergraduate or graduate student.
- 4: Has a GPA above 3.0.

# **Application Process**

#### **TIMELINE**

- Applications are due Nov. 30, 2019
- Candidates may be asked for an interview conducted in early December.
- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by Dec. 15 of that year. Applicant will include address
  of University's Financial Aid Office so that a scholarship check may be sent.

#### SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE

- Completed application form (including essay)
- Official proof of academic standing.
- A letter of academic references from a guidance counselor or teacher.
- A letter of reference completed by an employer or other community member.
- Proof of acceptance at a selected school for post-secondary studies.

### **SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

- Awards will be notified by **Dec. 15, 2019**.
- Applicant must provide their student ID, the correct mailing address of their institution and the department where their scholarship check is to be used.
