

Grant Application



Grants are available for non-profit, 501(c)3 organizations to attend Butterfly Wonderland. The funds are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Due to high volume of guests and school trips during March and April, your trip may not be scheduled during those months, please inquire for more information. Large tours of 100 must be broken up into two tour times due to our facility not being able to accommodate those numbers.

The Butterfly Wonderland Foundation collects funds through events, workshops, and donations as well as the management of specific product sales within Butterfly Wonderland. The grants enable students and groups to visit Butterfly Wonderland on a self-guided tour and discover a world-class attraction with a highly innovative, rainforest environment featuring the largest indoor butterfly pavilion in America. These funds from corporations, foundations and individuals are donated to the 501(3)c Foundation of Butterfly Wonderland, which then awards Title One schools and other organizations with non-profit status that might otherwise not be able to attend the facility based on each grant's requirements.

- Grants are awarded based on the number of individuals attending and are calculated at a discounted rate.
- Minimum group size is 10 and maximum group size is 100 - including students, chaperones, etc.

Change/Cancellation Policy:

Changes to a reservation must be obtained no later than one week in advance. Group contact must call (480) 800-3000, ext. 206. Due to donation requirements, usage timelines, and available funds, approval for any increase in the number of students must be obtained in advance. Groups arriving with an unauthorized group size will need to submit payment for the additional students and/or adults upon arrival. Cash, business check, credit card or PO will be accepted. We encourage school districts to pay via purchase order to receive an invoice rather than bringing a pre-printed check that does not reflect accurate tour numbers. No refunds will be given for dropped numbers the day of visit on pre-written checks.
