Scholarship Application



Scholarships are available for Arizona Department of Education designated Title I schools. The funds are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Due to a high volume of guests and school trips, scholarships are not awarded during March and April. Large tours of 80 or more may be broken up into two tour times. Please plan accordingly for the delay with lunches, staggered arrival, etc. and inquire for more information.

Change/Cancellation Policy:

Changes to a reservation must be obtained no later than one week in advance. Group contact must call (480) 800-3000, ext. 206.
